



From 1 January 2015, schools and academies across England are legally required to ensure milk is made available during the school day to all students who want it. This is because milk is an important part of a child's diets. The actual requirement is as follows: "Lower fat milk or lactose-reduced milk must be available for drinking at least once per day, during school hours."

In practice, this means that schools and academies can make milk available at either mid-morning or afternoon break or at lunchtime. This standard is not met by providing milk at breakfast clubs or after school clubs.

Arrangements at Bradfields Academy

Semi-skimmed milk will be available in the dining hall at lunch time for any student regardless of whether they have a cooked meal, packed lunch, free meal or pay for lunch. Please encourage your son/daughter to take advantage of this.
